

College Drive/Hwy 19 Reconstruction Project



WHAT ARE WE DOING ON COLLEGE DRIVE/HWY 19?

MnDOT is planning to reconstruct College Dr./Hwy 19 from 4th Street to Bruce Street in the City of Marshall in 2025. The road pavement has deteriorated and the city of Marshall needs to replace aging utilities. MnDOT and the City of Marshall are partnering together on this large project.

WHAT WE HEARD

“The intersection at Country Club Drive is confusing. Drivers aren’t sure what to do.”

“There are a lot of trucks coming through town and making a turn onto College Dr./Hwy 19 is really tough for them and us.”

“It is really hard to turn onto College Dr/Hwy 19 at the Marshall St bridge. You just can’t see.”

COMMUNITY PRIORITIES

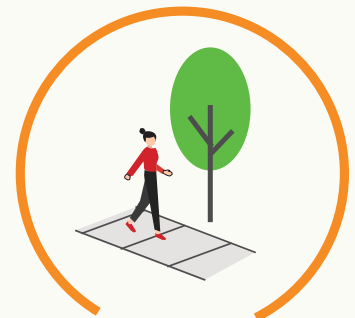

We will listen and account for the community’s input while considering improvement options for the project, and we will provide feedback to the community on how their input influenced project decisions.

WHO WE HEARD FROM

Face to face meetings and an online survey gathered input from the community on their priorities for College Dr./Hwy 19.

OVER 500 PARTICIPANTS provided hundreds of comments in several languages including English, Somali, Spanish and the Karen languages.

NEXT STEPS

Using the input we heard from the community, MnDOT and the City of Marshall are developing corridor recommendations. Starting in early summer of 2020, the community will be asked to give their feedback on potential improvements.
